

REALITY OF BADMINTON MOVEMENT AMONG WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES IN SON LA CITY

Abstract:

In the research process, we have identified the status of badminton movement among the Son La workers and employees on the basis of analyzing the activities of badminton clubs in political organizations, administration in Son La city, thereby creating a scientific basis for solutions developing badminton for workers and employees of Son La city.

INTRODUCTION

In recent years, the badminton movement among workers and employees in Son La city has grown quite strongly. Many badminton tournaments for workers and employees have been organized. This is an opportunity for workers and employees to exchange and learn experiences, promote the movement of health training, improve the cultural and spiritual life, contributing to the successful implementation of assigned tasks.

The development of badminton movement among workers and employees in Son La city is shown through the activities of badminton clubs. Currently, the city has 56 badminton clubs for workers and employees with more than 1513 members. Every year, apart from practicing in provincial badminton system, club members also participate in friendly tournaments, as well as national tournaments and have achieved encouraging achievements. However, in order to promote the badminton movement among workers and employees in Son La city to further develop, there must be appropriate solutions based on necessary scientific bases.

RESEARCH METHODS

The research process uses the following methods: Methods of analyzing and synthesizing documents; Methods of sociological investigation; Statistical mathematical methods.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

In order to understand the badminton movement among workers and employees in Son La city, the topic investigated the reality of badminton clubs in political and administrative organizations; Badminton tournament system for workers and employees, as well as the achievements of badminton clubs in 2018. The results are presented in Tables 1, 2 and 3.

The results in Table 1 show that, in the political and administrative organizations in Son La city, there are 56 badminton clubs with 1513 members. There are 143 badminton yards, of which 79 are covered (accounting for 55.24%), annual operating expenses under the budget is VND 1,188 million, and socialization is VND 1,375 million. In general, the number of badminton clubs and members in political and administrative organizations in Son La city is quite crowded. However, the operating cost of badminton clubs is very limited (24.51 million VND / club / year), and the number of unguarded training grounds is still high (44.72%). These are problems that significantly affect the development of the badminton movement in political and administrative organizations in Son La city.

The results in Table 2 show that the system of badminton tournaments for officers and officials in Son La City in 2018 includes the tournament, with 119 delegations and 1076 athletes participating. Of which, 56 athletes

(5.2%) were officers and 623 athletes were officials (accounting for 57.89%). In addition to the city's badminton system, athletes can also participate in friendly and national and industry tournaments, but the participation of these categories by city workers and employees is quite small due to the low budget for activity.

The results in Table 3 show that the badminton clubs in the contingent of workers and employees of Son La city achieved a total of

18 medals, including 5 gold, 5 silver and 8 bronze in the following prizes: National middle-aged badminton tournament ; Badminton tournament for clubs in provinces and cities; Northern Region Badminton tournament for Banking sector; National Badminton tournament in Northern Region .

Thus, in 2018 the workers and employees of Son La city won only 4 awards out of 15 tournaments at all levels inside and outside the city

(accounting for 26.66%). The workers and employees of Son La city mainly achieve high results in the tournaments for middle aged athletes and the sector’s tournament. This shows the attention of a number of departments in the city, especially the education and water supply sector’s in the development of the badminton movement among workers and employees in Lai Chau city. This is a positive factor which needs to be promoted and replicated widely in the city.

CONCLUSION

Badminton movement among workers and employees in Son La city is currently developing quite strongly, especially the intensity of the movement. However, in addition to the achievements of the movement, there are still shortcomings such as the limited investment and funds, there are many uncovered training ground, inadequate attention of some departments and committees. In order to promote the badminton movement among

workers and employees in Son La city and to further develop the badminton movement among workers and employees in Lai Chau city in the coming time, there should be appropriate solutions.
